



Used as fabulous antique flooring today, Parefeuille was originally used as ceiling tiles in French barns and stables. Combined with hay, this is how the French sheltered their livestock and kept them cool in the summer and warm in the winter. Today we use Parefeuille in our home because of its rich coloration, warmth, and sense of history.

Product Usage Recommendations

- Suitable for all indoor wall and medium duty flooring applications.
- Outdoor use subject to climate and method of installation.
- Will exhibit uneven surface texture and thickness may vary from piece to piece.

Installation & Maintenance Guidelines

- Install per industry standards for antique terra cotta.
- Always inspect material prior to installation, installed material cannot be accepted for return or credit.
- Always lay out material prior to installation to properly blend and balance color and size.
- This is a reclaimed product and may require special cleaning prior to installation.
- Efflorescence may occur, especially following installation and in wet locations requiring special cleaning.
- Due to uneven thickness, may require a mud set installation.
