

Ogassian Brise

This grand scale sculptural expression stems from Artist Daniel Ogassian's love of the glass and cinder block designs that become all the rage in the 1950s and 1960s interior design. Brise can be used to accentuate and decorate existing walls, or configured to uniquely address dividing space into effective lifestyle solutions.

RECOMMENDED USE

- Suitable for indoor wall applications
- Suitable for use in wet areas
- Suitable for high temperature areas
- Outdoor use subject to climate and method of installation



INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

- Please reference the manufacturer's install instructions
- Installation of Brise screen blocks requires installation by a licensed stone mason. You may also need to consult with a structural engineer depending on your specific installation
- Seal materials annually or as needed. Exterior or wet area applications may require more frequent sealing.
- Clean with soapy water or a mild, non-acidic and non-abrasive cleanser
