In 1980, while shopping for a wedding dress, Ann Sacks, herself, discovered a box of Mexican Talavera tiles being sold as trivets. These "trivets" inspired her to start her own tile company. Her business quickly outgrew the space, so in 1981 she opened her first store, selling an assortment of Mexican Artisan tiles.

She quickly learned that popular demand was not limited to the Mexican tiles. By an initial request to match tile to KOHLER plumbing products, Ann decided to work with local ceramicists to develop a unique line of color tiles. Within two years, this handmade tile line offered 100 colors that could be matched to any existing product.

The success of the program allowed her to open showrooms in both Seattle and Vancouver. She continued to broaden the collections in the mid to late 80's to include limestone, marble, and granite. Working with suppliers in Italy, Ann began to address a more modern aesthetic. During this time, the partnership with Kohler began to flourish. It appeared to be a perfect match – expressing luxury style and lifestyle through product design. These matching philosophies of interior design led the Kohler Company to purchase ANN SACKS Tile & Stone in late 1989, to be a part of the KOHLER Interiors Group.

Headquartered in Portland, OR ANN SACKS today has showroom locations across the United States and in London.
