Martyn Lawrence Bullard's Hermitage mirrored tiles takes its cues from 20th century design, yet remain true to ANN SACKS' handcraft by employing the art of 18th century mirror making techniques to achieve the lustrous surfaces. The antiqued mirrored tiles are patterned with designs such as zebra, and leopard, creating a look that is reminiscent of the decorative art of verre églomisé, a difficult, almost extinct technique mastered by the French in the 18th century.



RECOMMENDED USE

- All vertical, dry indoor applications.

INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

- Please reference the TCNA handbook for installation of glass tile, ceramic tile and stone tile (www.tcnatile.com)
- A grout joint of 1/16" or greater is recommended
- Do not butt joint glass. Glass expands and contracts and will crack if butt jointed.
- Use non-sanded grout if grout is desired
- Clean with non abrasive, non acidic neutral cleaner or glass cleaner

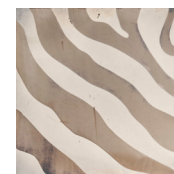
