Our Yakisugi porcelain collection is inspired by the art form known as shou-sugi-ban or yakisugi, the ancient Japanese technique of charring wood to preserve and antique its composition, increasing its strength and visual character. Still coveted for its unique beauty and rarified nature, ANN SACKS brings the same graphic characteristics to interiors and exteriors in a forgiving porcelain tile that caters to today's busy lifestyles.



## RECOMMENDED USE

- Matte formats suitable for indoor wall and flooring applications. Gloss formats are suitable for wall applications and limited residential flooring only.
- Outdoor use subject to climate and method of installation, matte formats not affected by freeze/thaw
- Select Testing available upon request
- Please see Ann Sacks slip resistance and wet flooring application statement to determine usage in a wet area



## INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

- Install per TCNA Handbook for ceramic tile ([www.tcnatile.com](http://www.tcnatile.com))
- Plank formats may exhibit some warping therefore it is recommended to plan either straight set or maximum 1/3 offset joint pattern
- Always inspect material prior to installation, installed material can not be accepted for return or credit
